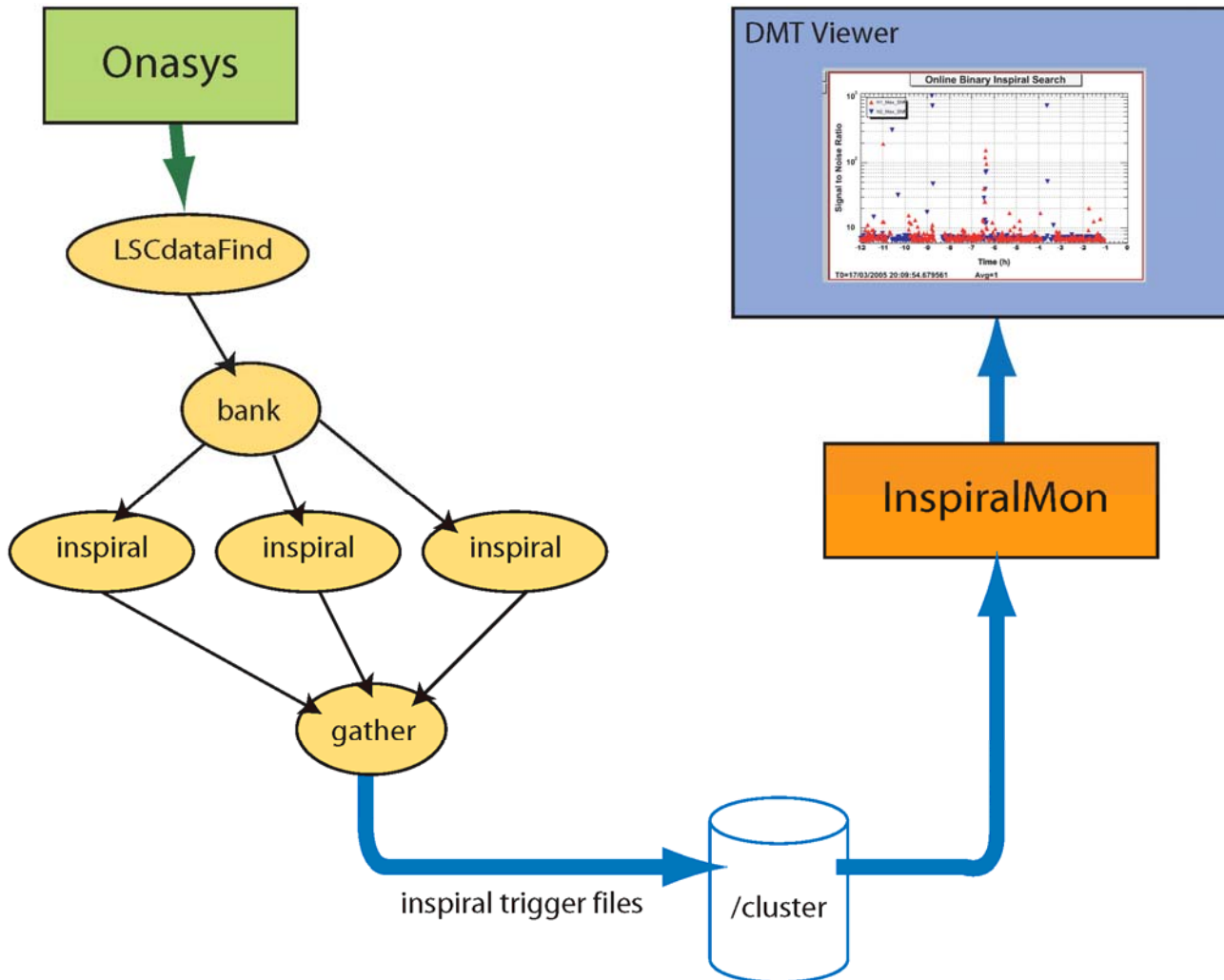

Introduction

- Goal is to provide low latency feedback from online inspiral search to scimons and operators in a familiar format
- InspiralMon is not really a monitor... (does not generate inspiral triggers)
- Watches for new output from the online inspiral search
- Create summary information for display in DMT Viewer

How does it work?



What information is available?

- Number of inspiral triggers per 60 seconds
- Minimum, mean, maximum of inspiral trigger SNR every 60 seconds
- Time series showing if data has been analyzed
- Histogram of trigger SNR for last 2, 6 and 12 hours

DMT Viewer Display

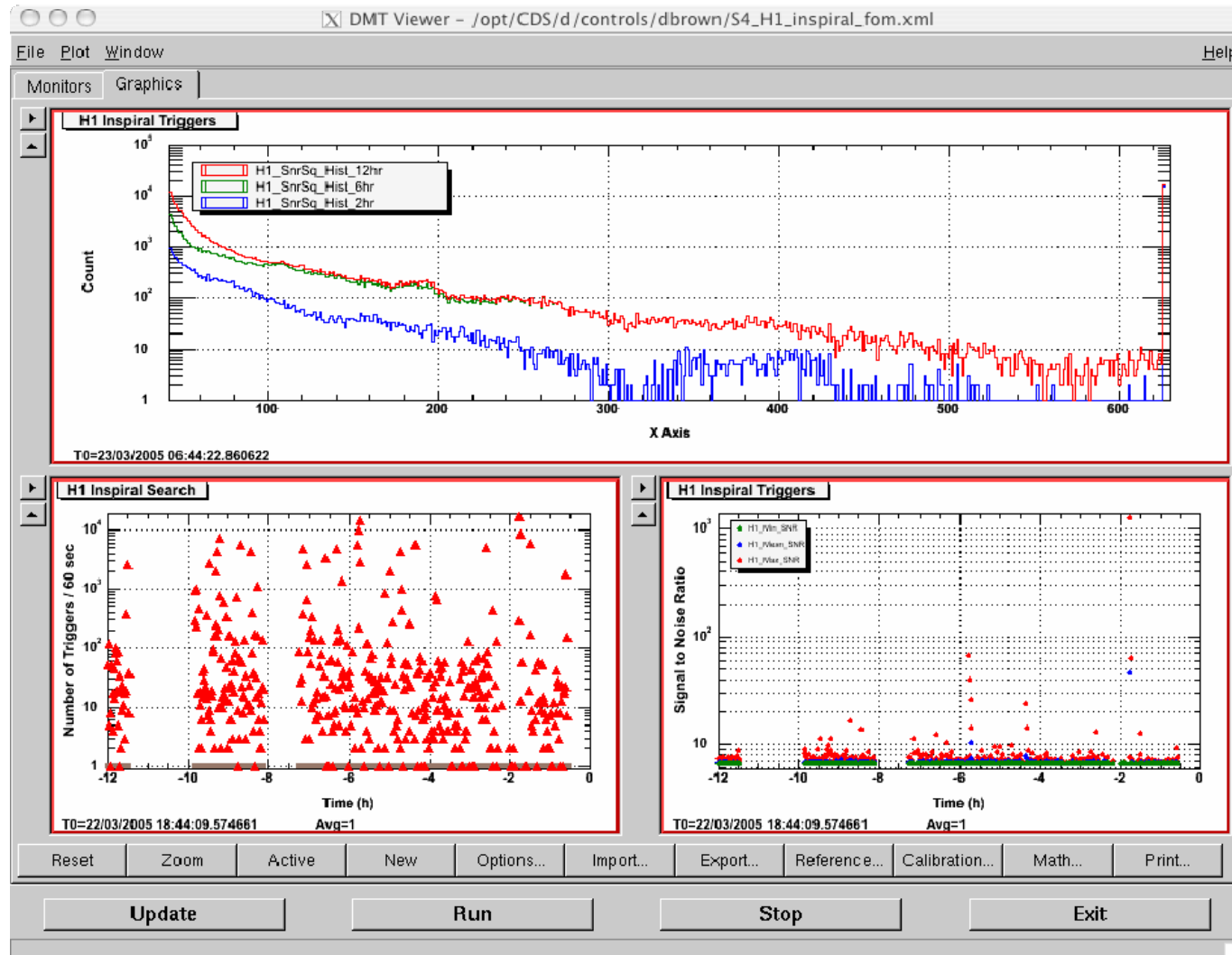
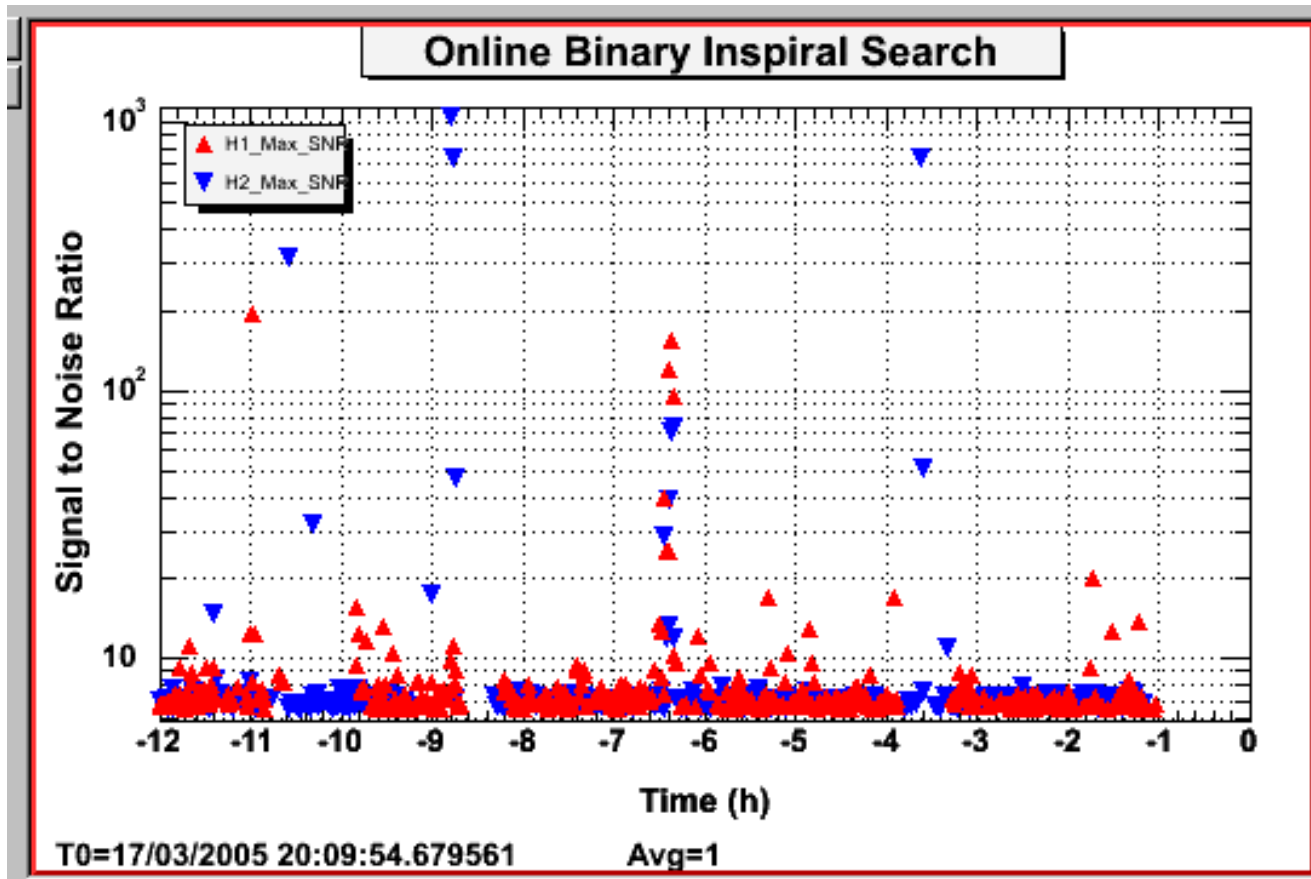


Figure of Merit

What's next?

- Store summary information in trend frames
- Reduce latency of inspiral trigger generation
 - » Between 5 and 15 mins
- Nothing in InspiralMon is really inspiral specific...
 - » Class to watch for new trigger files
 - » Class to generate summary information
- Generalise summary class to other online searches
 - » Excess Power (Kipp Cannon)
- Keep it running between now and S5
