- PRIMARY PURPOSE WAS TO PROVIDE SHADE (IT DOES GET HOT IN LOUISIANA)
- AN ARBOR OR ROOF ONLY STRUCTURE
- SPECIFIC DESIGN WAS LEFT TO PROPOSERS TO SUBMIT FOR APPROVAL

SCHEDULE

PROVIDED TO BIDDERS IN THE RFP

- TO BE COMPLETED BEFORE NOV 12, 1999
- PHASE-1 COMPLETION 90 DAYS ARO
- PHASE-2 COMPLETION 90 DAYS AFTER COMPLETION OF PHASE-1
- CONTRACTOR WAS TO BE FLEXIBLE TO START PHASE-2 EARLIER IF SO DIRECTED BY LIGO

RESPONSES TO RFP

- THREE PROPOSALS WERE RECEIVED
 - TWO OF THE THREE PROPOSALS WERE MINIMAL IN RESPONSE
 - LIGO DECIDED TO EVALUATE ALL THREE
- PROPOSAL EVALUATION CRITERIA
 - LISTED IN THE RFP
 - SPECIFICALLY ENUMERATED DURING THE PRE-BID CONFERENCE
